Review: From Chapter 1, we learn this about Jesus (Sermon preached on June 30, 2019)

1. He is heir of all things (v2)
2. He made the world (v2)
3. He is the radiance of God's glory (v3)
4. He is the exact representation of God's nature (v3)
5. He upholds all things by the word of His power (v3)
6. He made purification of sins (v3)
7. He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high (v3)
8. He is not an angel, he is much better (v4)
9. He has inherited a more excellent name— Son (v4-5)
10. He is to be worshiped (v6)
11. He is declared to be God (v8)
12. His throne is forever (v8)
13. His enemies will be made a footstool for his feet (v13)
